Important information

- The competition will be run from the clubhouses in compliance with the [British Rowing Rules of Racing](#) and Rowsafe.
- Entry fees are £12 per seat payable on BROE before the closing date.
- Please note that as river conditions can vary we reserve the right to change the length of the course, race upstream or withdraw certain boat categories for safety reasons if necessary.
- Senior events may be split into bands against competitors of similar ranking index.
 - The aim will be for no less than 4 and no more than 8 crews per band but racing against an appropriate ranking will take priority.
 - Similar will apply to masters and junior crews should there be a large entry.
- Masters crews with no opposition and where an event cannot be formed through a handicap, will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index unless they specify otherwise.
- Beginner events are restricted to crews with an average ranking of 3 points or fewer per seat. For example, a quad should have a **combined CRI of 12 points or fewer** to be eligible for the beginner category.
 - The Organising Committee reserves the right to move crews that do not meet this criterion to a more appropriate event, where necessary to ensure fair and competitive racing.
 - Crews with no opposition will be moved to a suitable alternative event if appropriate ranking opposition is available.
- Juniors of J15 and above without opposition and unable to move up will be moved to Senior into a band of appropriate ranking index.
- Crews that cannot move up may row for time only for half the entry fee, crews with opposition will take priority.
 - Time only crews will NOT receive medals.
- The draw will be held at 20:00 on Monday 28 September at Burton Leander Rowing Club, DE15 9AE
